Exemption of Half the Tuition Fee

You are entitled to receive an exemption of half the tuition for the first year (two semesters) if you hold only a non-Japanese nationality and meet ALL of the following three conditions:

- 1. You have acquired the qualification required to apply for admission to Kyushu University outside Japan.
- 2. You reside outside Japan at the time of application.
- 3. You will obtain a new student visa and enter Japan to study at Kyushu University.

Tuition	Original Amount	After Exemption
1st year (per semester)	267,900	133,950
2nd year on (per semester)	267,900	Exemptions may be awarded *.

*Kyushu University has a support system for exemption of either the whole, half, or quarter of the tuition fee for one semester, and students can apply for these exemptions after enrollment.

MEXT Scholarship

(Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology)

(Up to 2 successful applicants)

- 119,000 yen/month
- ★Eligibility: Students who do NOT have Japanese nationality
- · Full waiver of tuition and enrollment fees
- · Airline tickets

Kyushu University International Undergraduate Scholarship

(Up to 2 successful applicants) 60,000 yen/month

- ★Eligibility: Students who do NOT have Japanese nationality and meet <u>ALL</u> of the conditions:
- 1. You have acquired the qualification to apply for Kyushu University outside Japan.
- 2. You reside outside Japan at the time of application.
- 3. You will obtain a new student visa and enter Japan to study at Kyushu University.
- *From the second year onwards a maximum of 2 students from all courses with a GPA of 3.0 or higher from the previous year will receive this scholarship.

Note: The terms of the scholarship and other aid are subject to change without prior notice



Dormitory

All successful applicants will be guaranteed a room in a university dormitory for at least six months. The students themselves will be responsible for the rent (around 20,000 yen a month).





Living Expenses

Living expenses in Fukuoka are approximately 82,000 JPY per month. This is lower than the national average.
